Several participants joined the meeting by phone and WebEx.

- 1. <u>Call to Order</u> Steven Memberg; in place for the Team Leader, Len Lindahl; called the meeting to order. He welcomed all public participants and took a roll call of Team members.
- 2. Review of December 5, 2014 Meeting: No comments.
- **3.** RWSP Deliverable Update: All documents were delivered to the Plan Team on schedule. An internal draft should be made available soon. Reg Team will review and provide comments.
- 4. Team Discussion of Future Regulatory Topics:
 - a. Success Principles: Final draft will be submitted by Ed de la Parte and distributed to the team.
 - b. Conjunctive Use: Draft will be resubmitted to the team for future discussion.
 - c. Domestic Self Supply: The team continued previous discussions relating to direction from the Steering Committee. In general, the team discussed background issues and will pursue additional information. Background:
 - Need to segregate discussion to be clear the Team is focused on self-supplied irrigation (SSI), not potable use. Suggest changing topic heading to reflect this.
 - RWSP shows that overall total DSS use is small and not expected to grow much.
 - Focus efforts geographically:
 - o Areas where increasing SSI would result in negative environmental performance.
 - Areas where reducing current levels of SSI would result in positive environmental performance
 - Need to discern economic considerations from resource protection
 - Regulatory options that would require statutory change may be difficult

Additional information needed:

- Summary of permitting classifications will be resubmitted to the team
- Utilities will provide locations of existing potable and reclaimed irrigation users
- WMDs will review number/location of well construction permits (coordination with delegated governments as necessary)
- WMDs will review year-round irrigation restrictions and compliance responsibilities
- **5. Pending Permit Applications**: No Team discussion occurred.
- 6. Open Discussion and Public Comment: No additional discussion occurred.

7. Review Schedule for Next Meeting: The next meeting was re-scheduled to Thursday, November 20, 2014 at 2:00 p.m. as a joint meeting with the Solutions Planning Team.
