SUMMARY OF THE MEETING

CENTRAL FLORIDA WATER INITIATIVE REGULATORY TEAM CONSUMPTIVE USE PERMITTING PRIORITIZATION MEETING

JUNE 24, 2015

The Consumptive Use Permitting Prioritization Subgroup of the Central Florida Water Initiative (CFWI) Regulatory Team held a meeting at 2:30 p.m. on Wednesday, June 24th via Teleconference.

- 1. The Subgroup Leader, Steven Memberg, opened the meeting by introducing the topic of prioritization and asked participants on the call to introduce themselves.
- 2. Participants were asked to identify specific permitting issues that needed to be addressed, similar to the recent CUPcon (Consumptive Use Permitting Consistency) process recently completed by the water management districts and FDEP.
- 3. The group identified several priority topics including:
 - Conditions for issuance
 - Uniform definition of harm
 - Uniform demand calculation by use class
 - Uniform conservation requirements calculation by use class
 - Use of MFLs and reservations in the permitting process
 - Single permitting model tool
 - Permitting thresholds
 - Permit compliance
 - Addressing potential impacts outside of the CFWI boundary
- **4.** Identified topics will be brought back to the Regulatory Team and future meetings may be set based on further direction.
