As part of the Central Florida Water Initiative (CFWI) 2025 Regional Water Supply Plan (RWSP) effort, the water management districts are currently requesting input and updates from stakeholders in the CFWI Planning Area on current and/or potential water supply, water resource development, and water conservation project options.

- Delete any projects that are no longer being considered for future development.
- Add any new projects that were not included in the 2020 CFWI RWSP.
